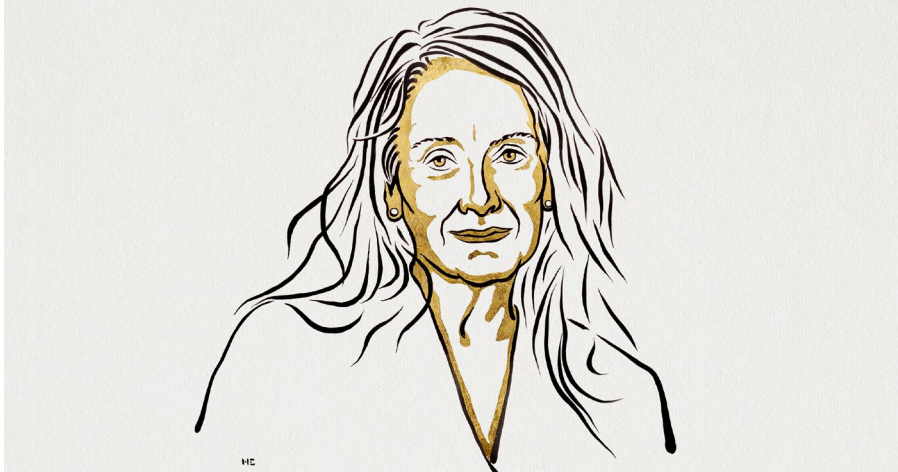


Student Assignment: Literature Prize 2022 Annie Ernaux



Annie Ernaux is awarded the Nobel Prize in Literature 2022 *“for the courage and clinical acuity with which she uncovers the roots, estrangements and collective restraints of personal memory”*.

Annie Ernaux’s books are often described as autobiographical, and yet not quite. It is as though she were *searching* for herself through fragmented memories from childhood, but in a way it is someone else she finds. And she uses the third-person voice in that search.
